I. Call to Order/Members Present

On April 15, 2020, at approximately 3:00 p.m., Chair Pantle called the virtual meeting of the Illinois Torture Inquiry and Relief Commission (TIRC or Commission) to order. II. Technical run-through of remote meeting procedures in anticipation of April 22, 2020 virtual regular meeting
